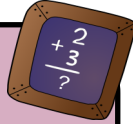


Maths Learning Development

Children will be extending place value and number skills in their own right as well as using them to add and subtract digits.

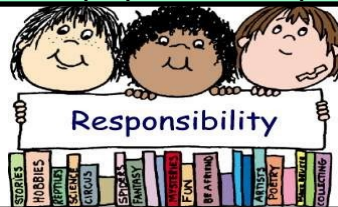


Thrive/P.H.S.E. Learning Development

Children will look into how they can make simple choices that will improve their health and wellbeing. Children will also think about taking on some new challenges with a positive mental attitude by collecting information, looking for help, making responsible choices and taking action.

Linked to our British Values children will be developing good relationships and respecting the differences between people and developing their confidence and responsibility to make the most of their abilities

They will learn the rules for, and ways of, keeping safe including basic road safety and about people who can help them to stay safe.



Literacy Learning Development

Children will reinforce their spelling awareness and use different strategies to help remember the trickier words.

Children will look at a range of information texts and how they are set out for different purposes as well as non-chronological reports.

KS3 will look at narrative writing.

Outdoor Learning Development

Winter - Children will learn to be comfortable working and being in outdoor spaces. To understand the changes that winter weather brings, and how to stay safe. To study local wildlife and plants and how they are changing. Children will use the natural environment to build shelters. Children will learn about navigation and map reading.



P.E. Learning Development

Children will be exploring dance this term. Children will be starting with simple movements and moving onto dances with a range of movements.

Children will be working on mastering basic movements and improving their coordination.



Topic - Citizenship

Children will focus on living in a Diverse Britain.

They will investigate different aspects of what makes Britain a special place to live and look at their own communities, and how they are made up. They will explore being brought up in a democracy and what our rights and responsibilities are how they protect us.

Children will learn about diversity: what it means; the benefits of living in a diverse community and about valuing the diversity within their community and what discrimination means
